



Algae Died B & Masonry Sealer

Sydney Hospital

LOCATION

Sydney Hospital (1st Hospital in Sydney), located on the site of Macquarie Street in Sydney's central business district.

The complete building and fountain is heritage.









ISSUES

- 1. The building and the fountain are all original Sydney sandstone. To maintain the sandstone characteristics, a product to seal the fountain has to be used.
- 2. To control the algae in the fountain, a product was needed to be added to the water, and not damaging the sandstone.









SOLUTION 1

To preserve the heritage, the fountain has been sealed with **Cyndan Masonry Sealer**.

This product was selected because it does not change the colour of the sandstone.





SOLUTION 2

Cyndan Algae Died B is used in the fountain to stop the growth of algae and also not damaging the sandstone.

The product does not bleach or change the colour of the sandstone, and it was used to the satisfaction of the Sydney Hospital maintenance team. The problem is now resolved and the fountain is free of algae.
